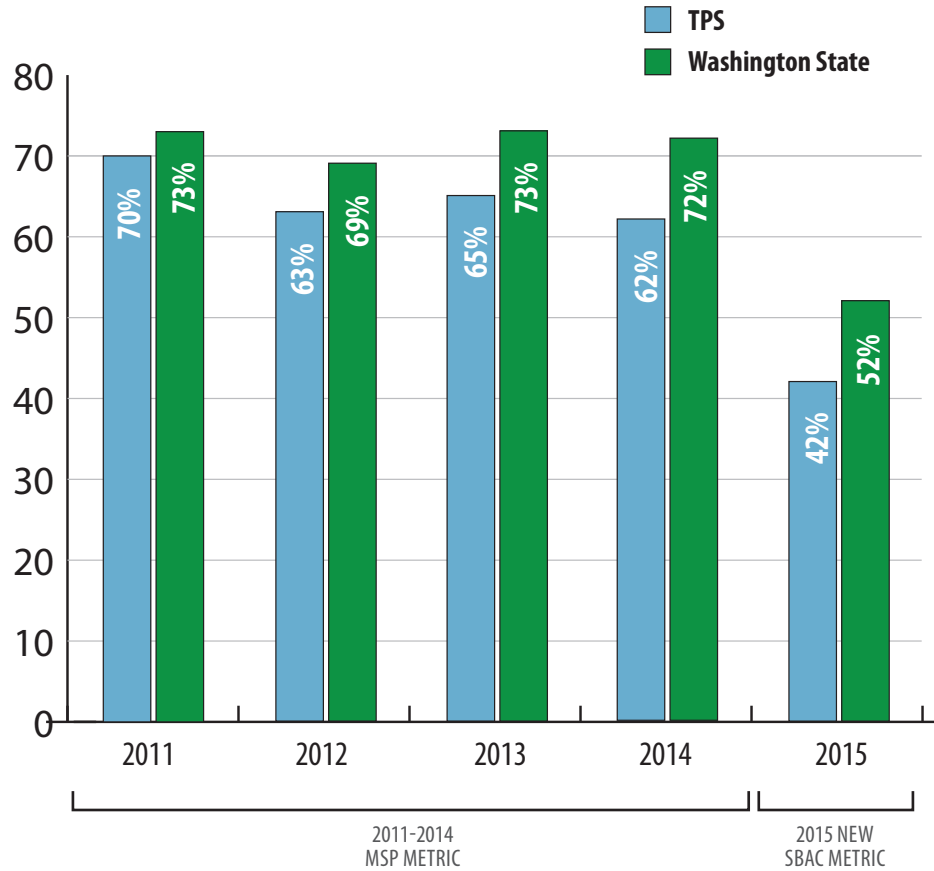
CLOSING THE GAP IN ALL 6 OF 6 DEVELOPMENTAL AREAS

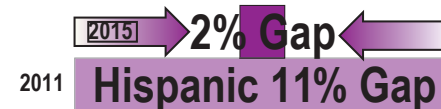

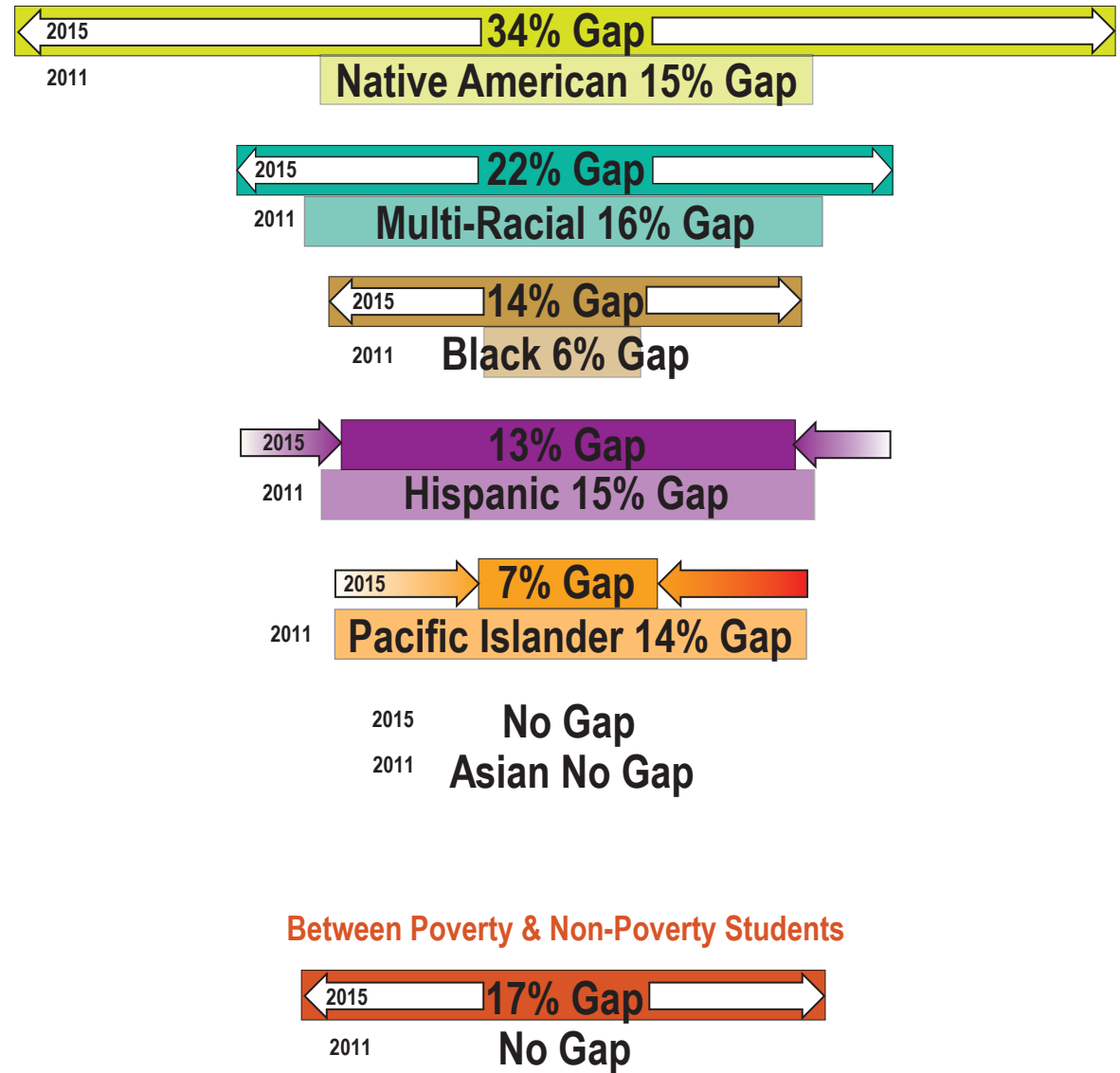

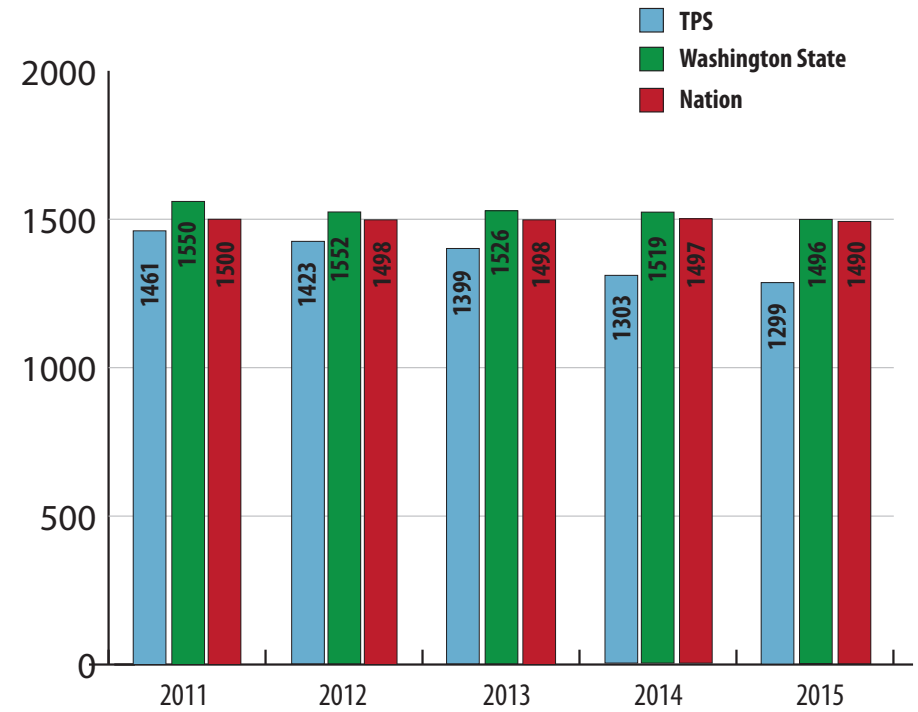

SAT & RELATED TESTS

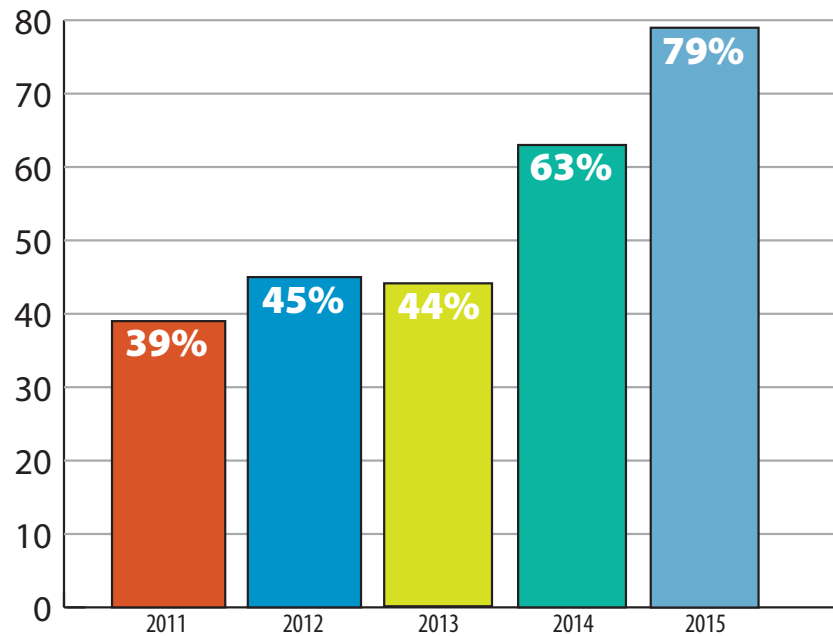

2011–15 SAT SCORES



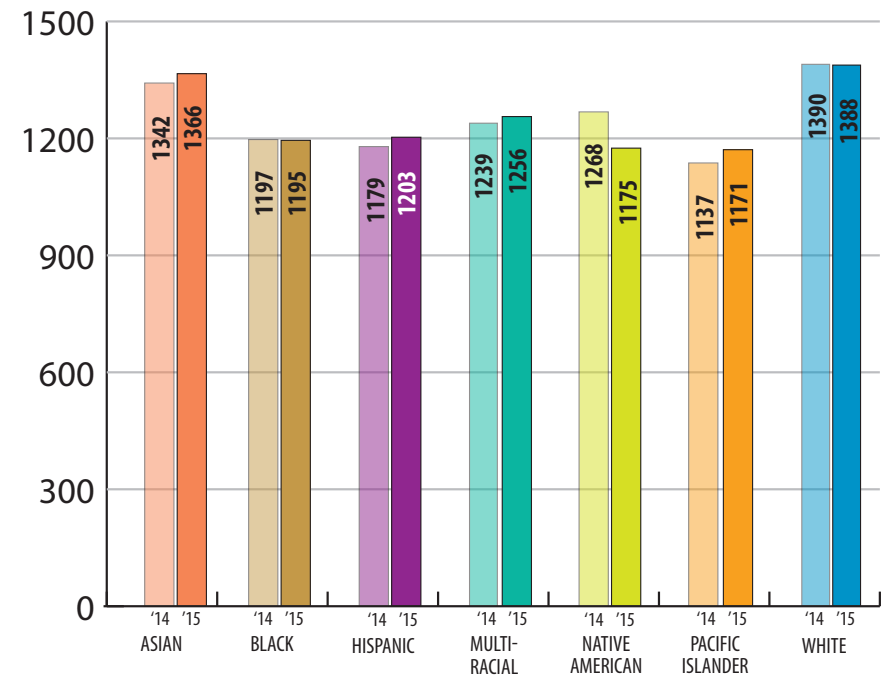

PERCENT OF TPS SENIOR COHORT TAKING SAT

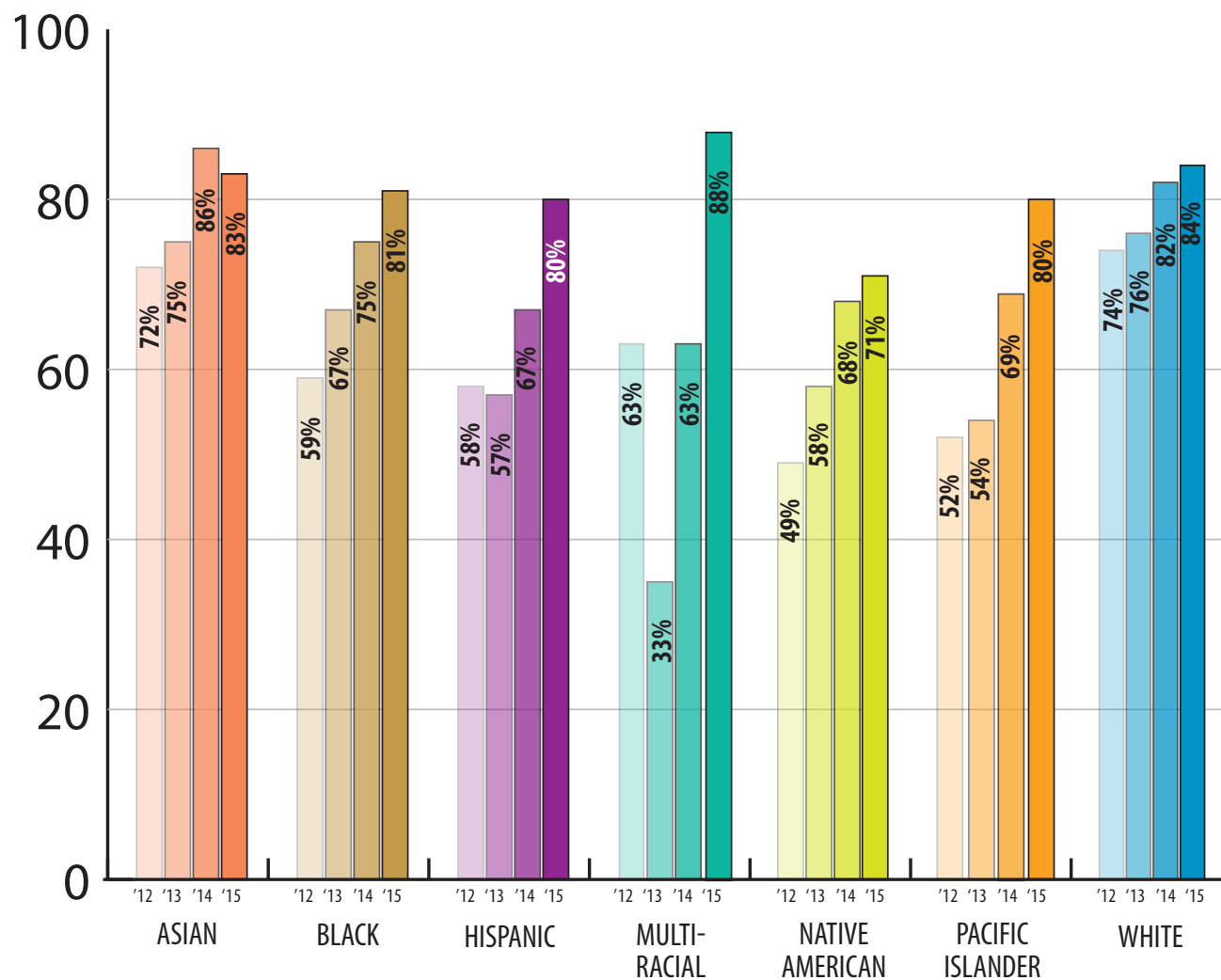

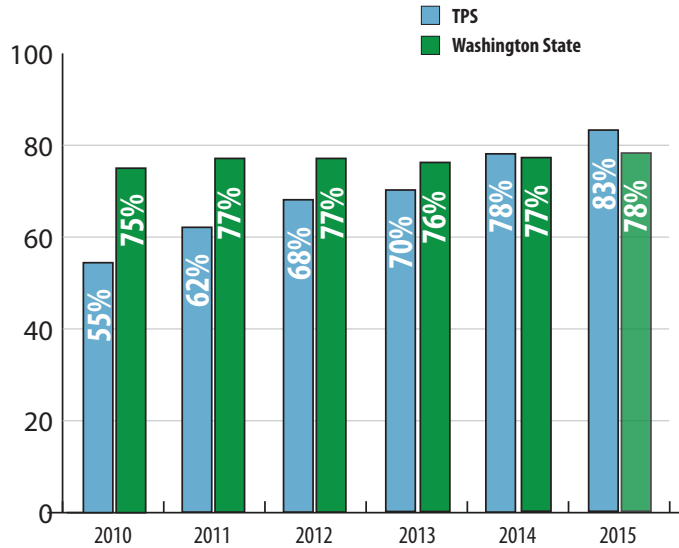


4-YEAR ON TIME GRADUATION

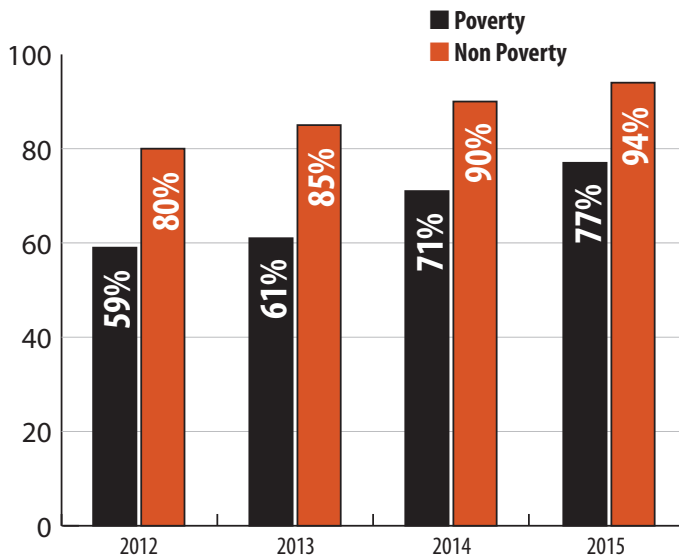

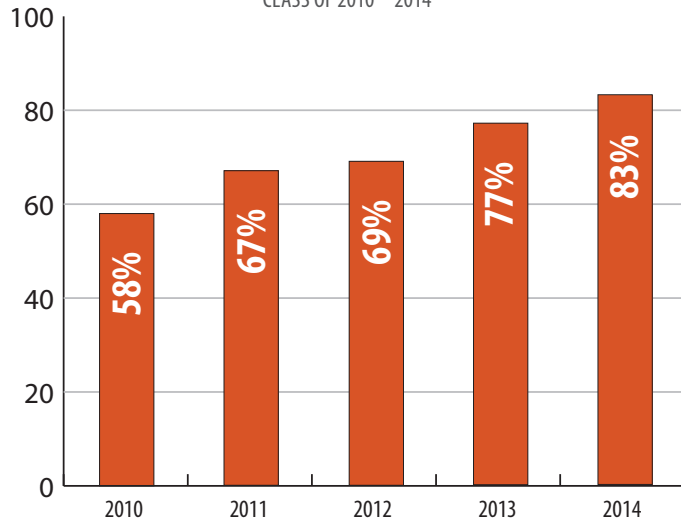

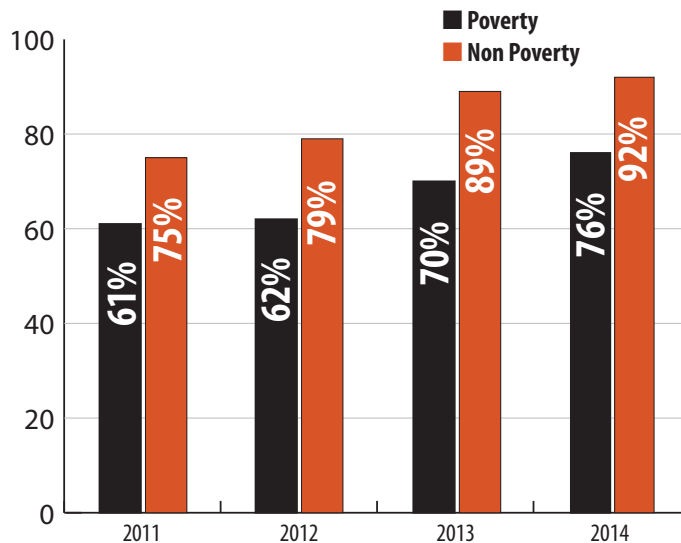

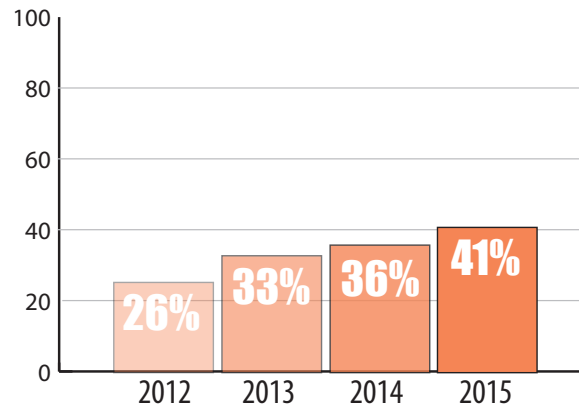

PERCENTAGE OF ELIGIBLE EIGHTH GRADERS SIGNED UP FOR COLLEGE BOUND SCHOLARS



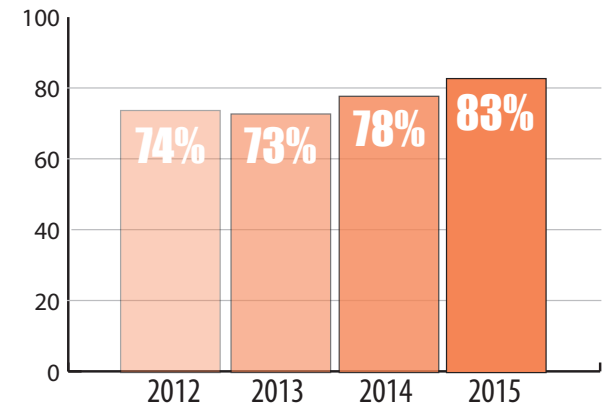

PERCENTAGE OF COLLEGE BOUND SCHOLAR STUDENTS IN SENIOR H.S. CLASS COHORT



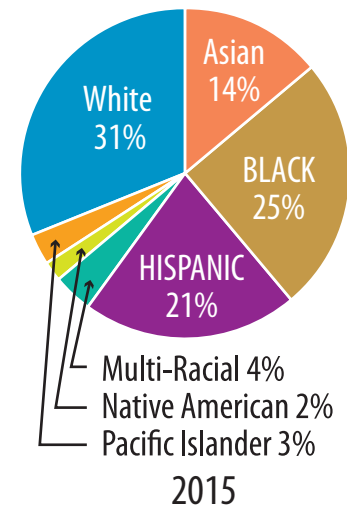
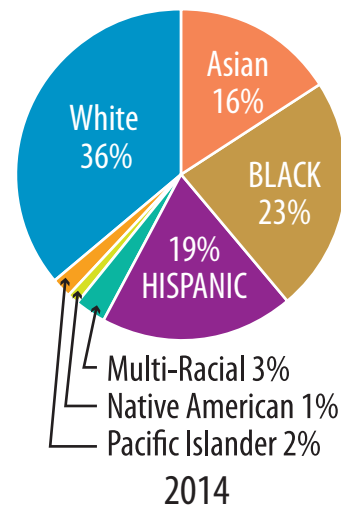
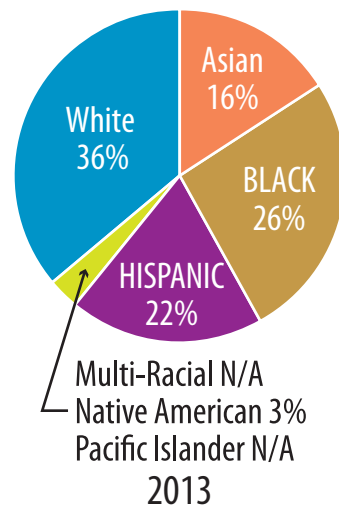
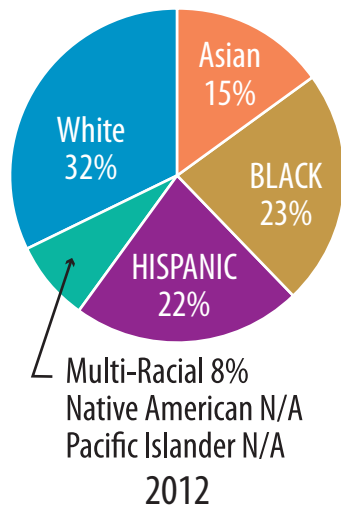

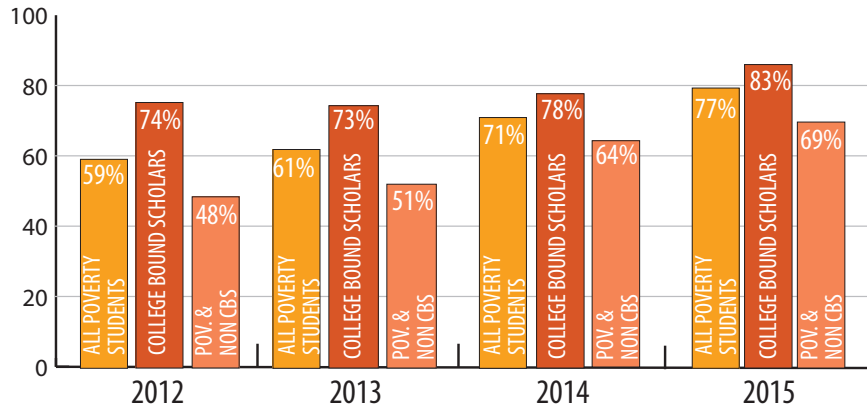

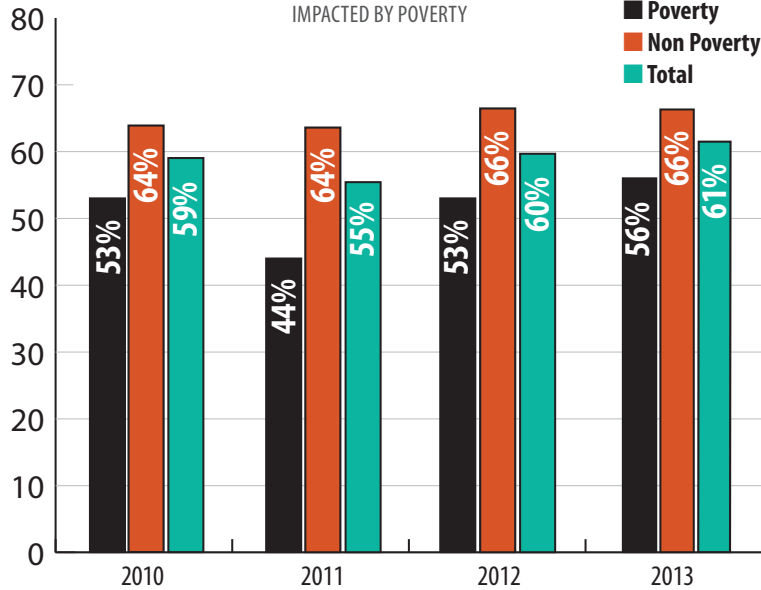

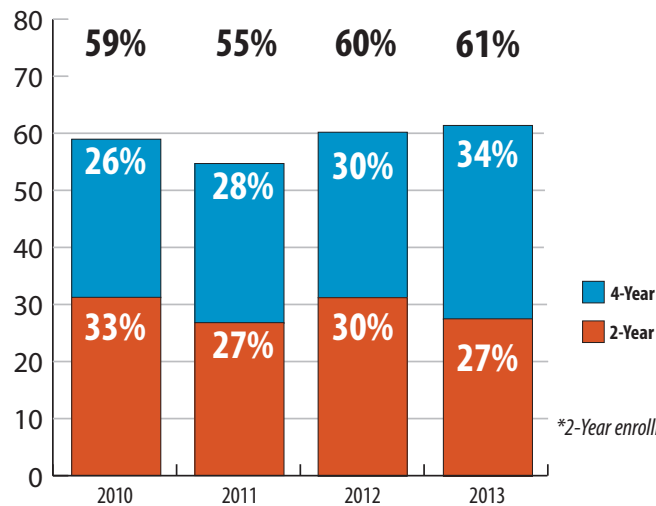
COMPARISON OF ALL STUDENTS IN POVERTY WITH COLLEGE BOUND SCHOLARS

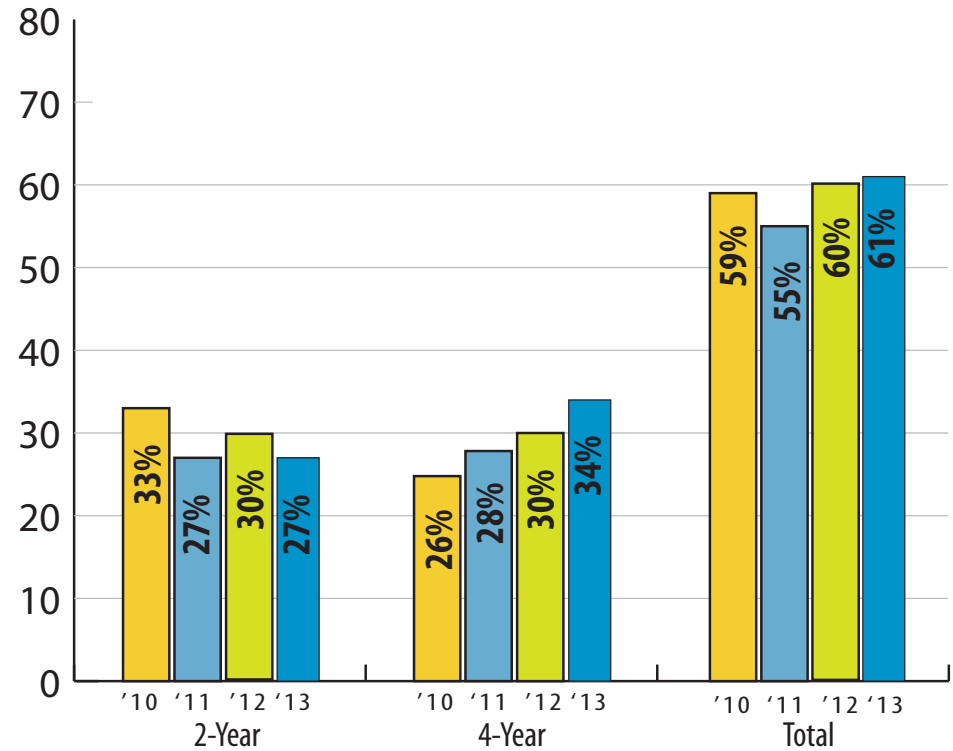

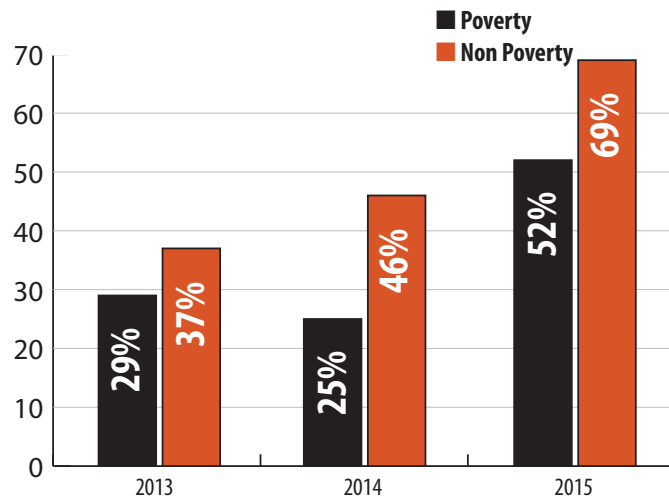




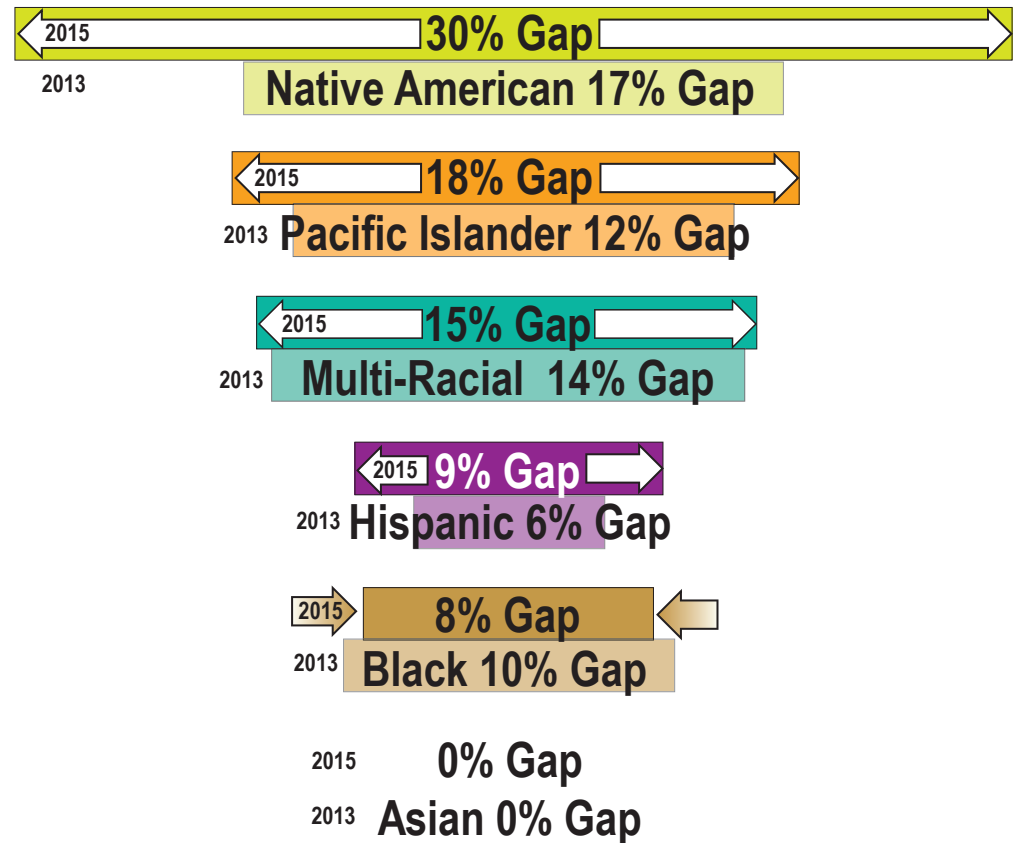
STUDENT ENROLLMENT IN COLLEGE-ELIGIBLE CLASSES
2013-15 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS



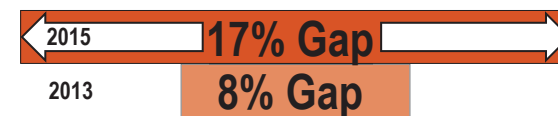

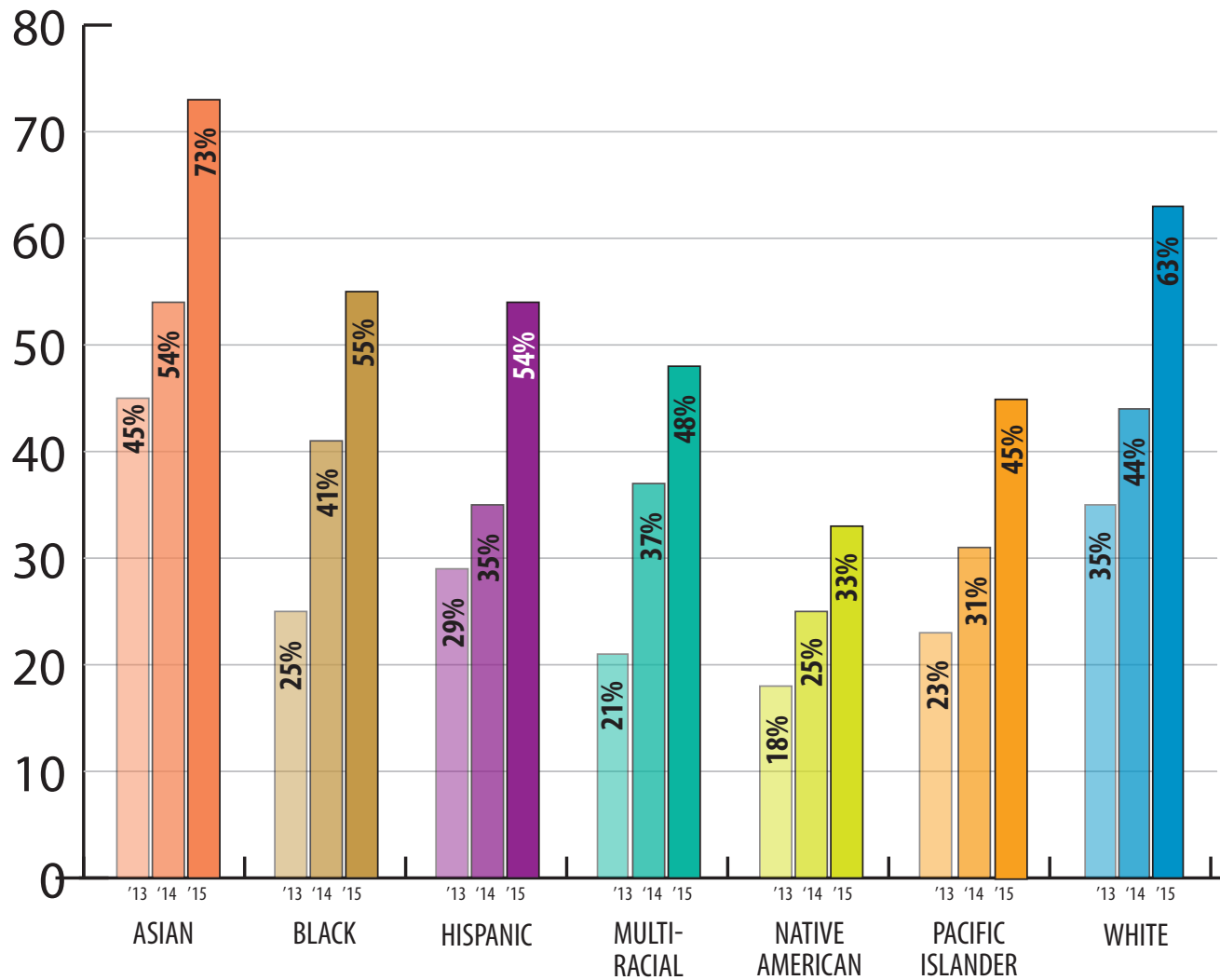

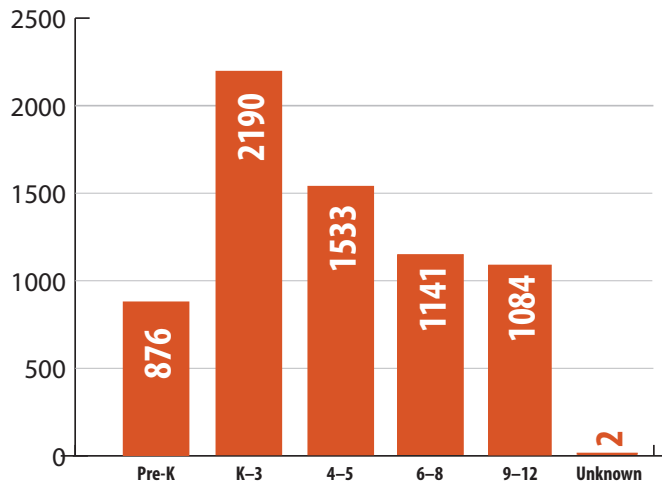


STUDENT ENROLLMENT IN COLLEGE-ELIGIBLE CLASSES
2013-15 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS • RACE AND ETHNICITY

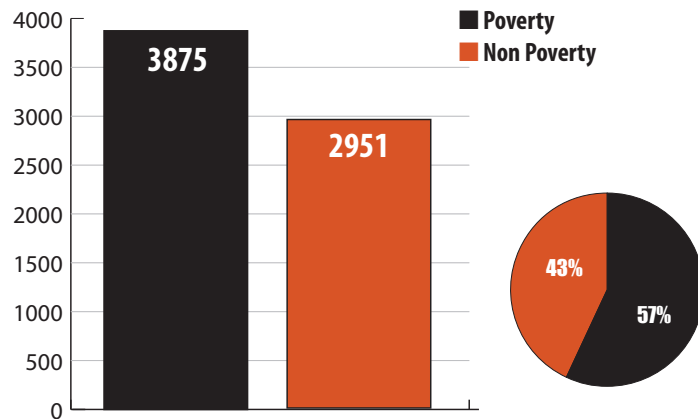

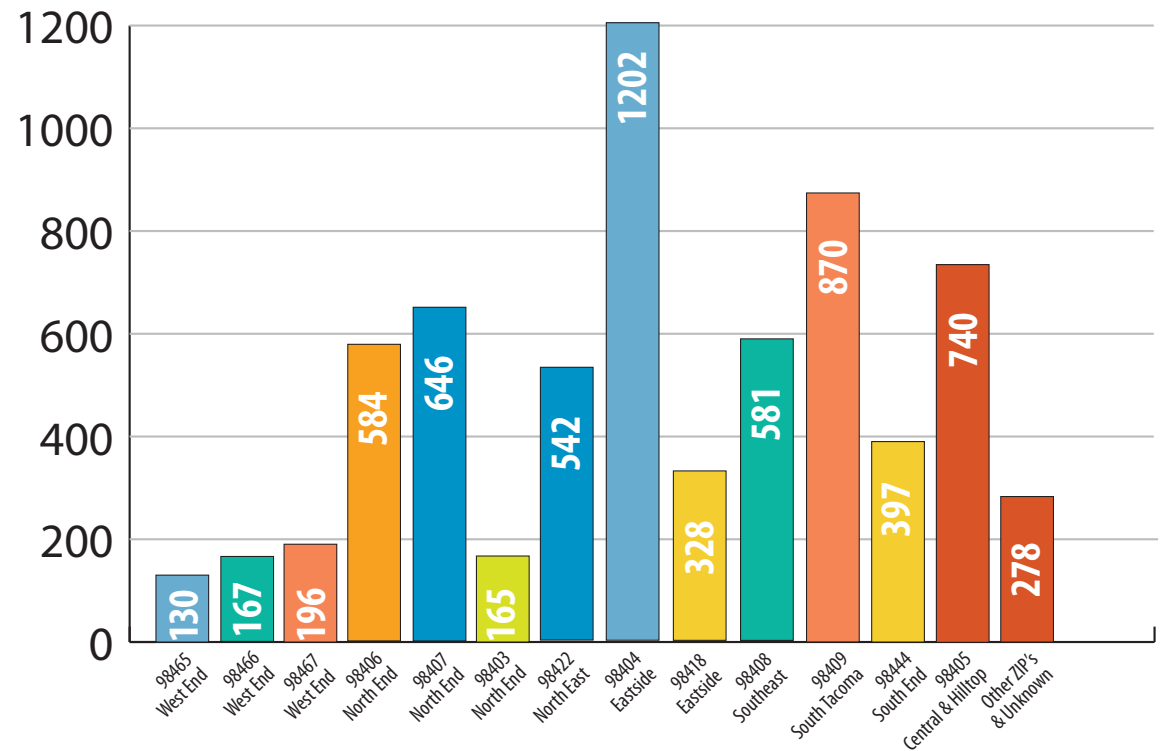

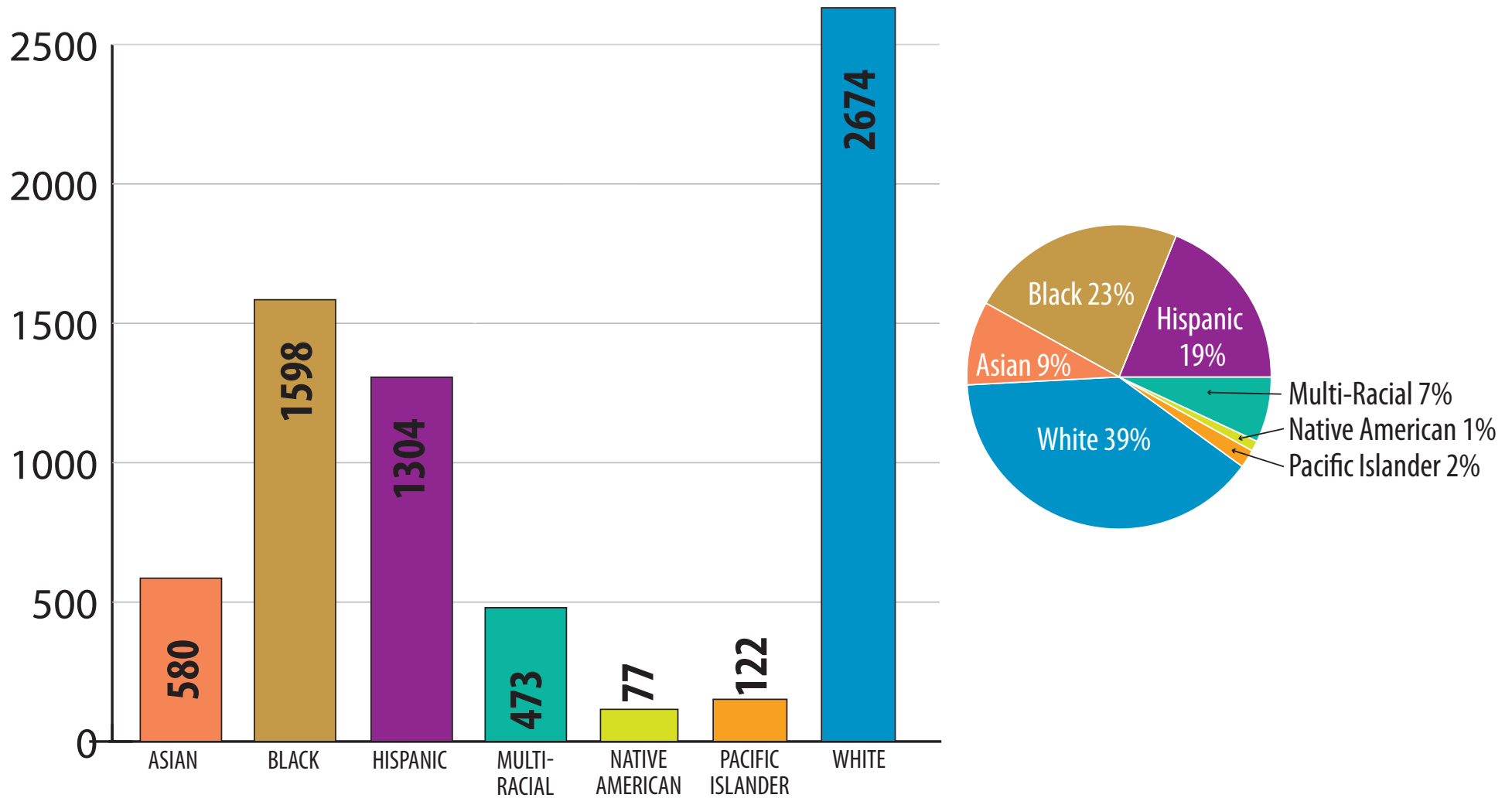

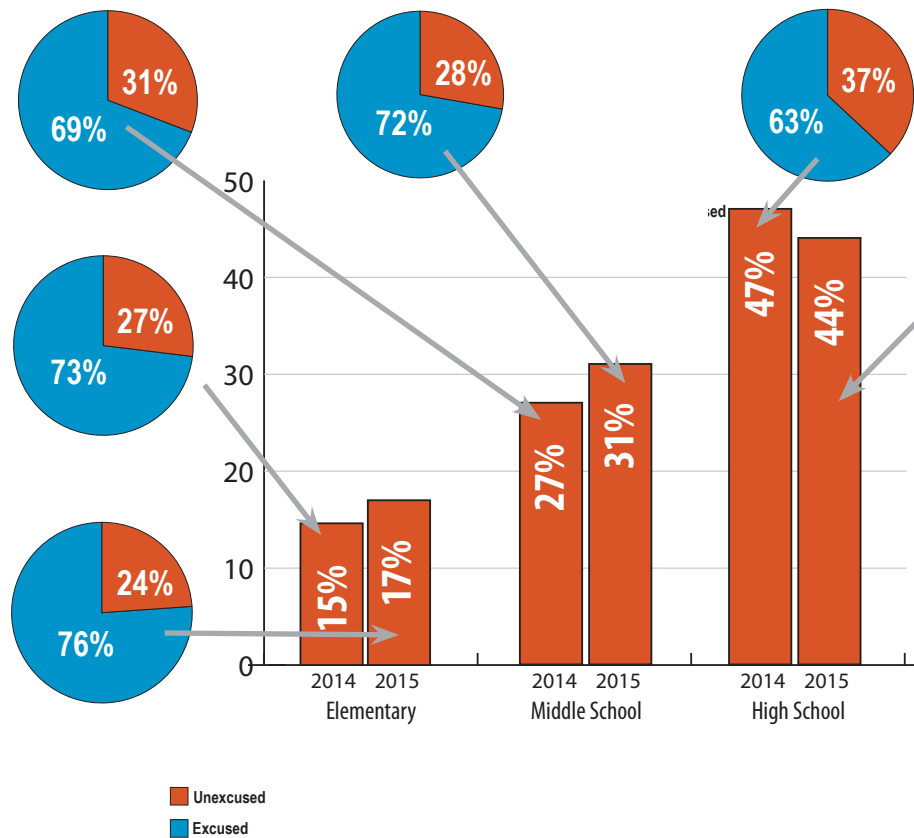

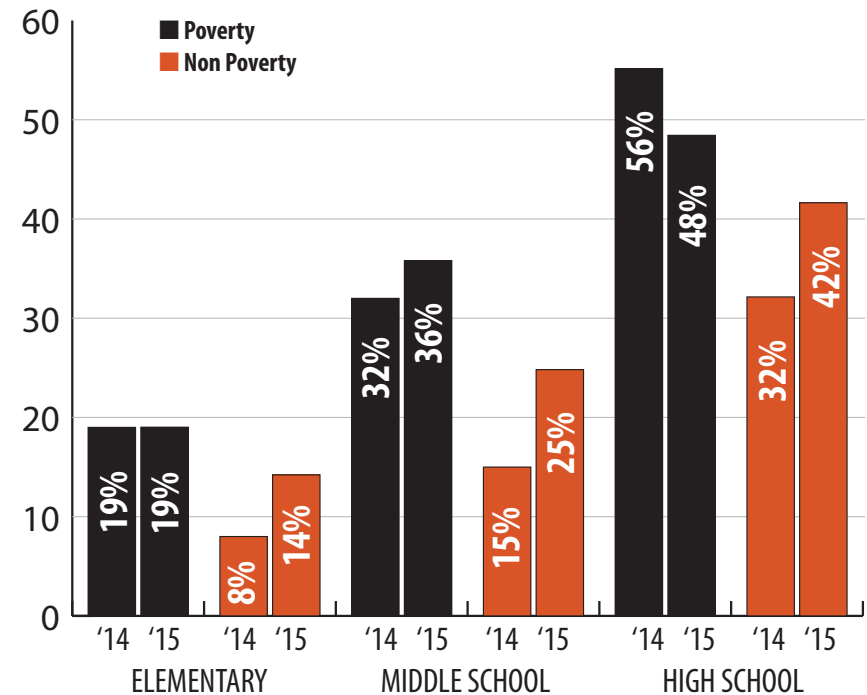
